REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1. **Only a parent, using his or her email, may register a student for a trip.**
2. **A headshot photo of your child must be uploaded during the booking process. Photos will be used for chaperone information on the trip.**
3. **Be ready to make your deposit payment by Discover, Mastercard or Visa. The registration process cannot be completed without payment.**

Eligibility

This tour is open to all students enrolled in West Aurora High School Blackhawks Marching Band program. Students must be in good standing and meet all of the school requirements to be eligible for a field trip.

Chaperones

We want to make this trip a success and we need adult chaperones to help us do that! Parents who are interested in being chaperones with the group should discuss their interest with Dr. Rodney Schueller. Selected chaperones will be notified by May 1 and will be sent instructions on how to register for the trip.

Reservations

Reservations are processed online and accepted on a first-come, first served basis. We will start a waitlist for the last motorcoach. Registration opens on February 1. Space is limited! Don't miss out & sign up early! Trip cost is based on a minimum of paying participants and may be adjusted. The payment schedule is as follows:

Mastercard, Discover & Visa are accepted for payments. Credit card charges will show up as **EBX*Entoura2708421148**. A \$25 fee incurred from denied charges will be passed along to your account if we receive a chargeback on your account.

Once you've created your registration account you will be able to go back in to make payments, view your purchases, update preferences and see any email communication that has been sent to you.

Rooming List

Every effort will be made to assign students to quad (4) occupancy rooms. Each room features 2 double beds. Students will sign up for rooms in class in September. Chaperones will be assigned to double occupancy rooms providing the numbers work out evenly. A single supplement charge is available for those that would like a single room.
